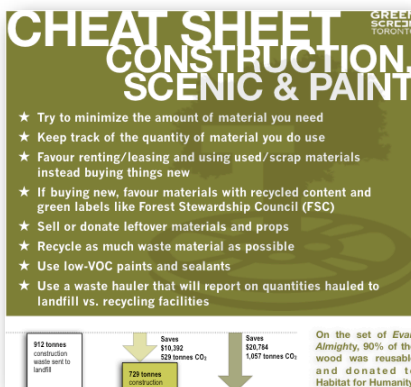
1. An Intro to Greening your Shoot
